Conditions

Conduct of Tournament

The tournament will be conducted under the Rules of Tennis as approved by the International Tennis Federation and Rules and Regulations and Code of Conduct of the Hong Kong Tennis Association.

Parent & Child Doubles

Eligibility

- Child must partner his/her father or mother
- Child must be born in 1992 or later
- Only 32 places are available, entries will be accepted on a first come first serve basis

Entries

Entries must be accompanied by the required entry fee to be paid by crossed cheque made payable to Hong Kong Tennis Association and sent to The Hong Kong Tennis Association at Room 1021 Olympic House, 1 Stadium Path, So Kon Po, Causeway Bay, Hong Kong. Entry fee per pair of \$800 will go to the HKTA for Junior Development. Each entrant along with participating in the event will get a souvenir pack, \$200 F&B coupon at the Club, with winners also receiving a trophy and prizes.

Time of Play

Matches will commence anytime from 9am

Format of Play

- All matches will be decided by a PRO SET. The PRO SET is won by the first pair to reach 8 games with at least 2 clear games. A Tie-Break game will be played if the score reaches 8 games all
- Semi Finals and Final will be decided by Best of 2 sets. If the match is tied at 1 set all, a 10-point SUPER TIE-BREAK will be played to determine the winner

Programme of Play

Details of the draw and schedules of the matches will be posted on HKTA's website (www.tennishk.org). Players are responsible for checking their playing schedule by accessing HKTA's website or contacting HKTA directly. The Club will not make any individual reminder. All competitors are expected to acquaint themselves with the hours at which they are to play and ready to play when their matches are called. All players not ready to play within fifteen (15) minutes after his/her match is called shall be defaulted unless the referee in his sole discretion, after considering of all relevant circumstances, elects not to declare a default.

Ladies' Doubles Challenge

Eligibility

Ladies 18 years or above at the time of the event.

Entries

An entry fee of \$600 per player should be paid by crossed cheque to The Clearwater Bay Golf & Country Club and sent to the Club. Entry fee includes participation in Ladies' Doubles Challenge event, souvenir pack, \$100 F&B coupon, lunch on 14 March at the Club, lucky draw, trophies for winners and runners-up of each category and free entry to watch the Hong Kong Tennis Champions Cup 2010.

Time of Play

9am to 1pm

Format of Play

- Doubles matches - with a different partner in each match
- Round Robin format
- Short deuce, play as many games within 25 minutes per match
- Guaranteed acceptance for the first 16 individual entries received per division (with payment). Others will be put on a waiting list.

Programme of Play

Ladies will be notified of match details via email prior to the event date.

Power of Tournament Committee

The Tournament Committee reserves the right in its discretion to alter the conditions and programme of the Tournament as it deems fit and proper including but not limited to: (1) cancel any of the events if the total entry is less than 8; (2) accept or reject any application; (3) run the Tournament strictly according to schedule and no postponement will be allowed; (4) alter the scheduled duration of the Tournament due to bad weather or any unforeseen happenings; and (5) move the competition venue to indoor court. All announced schedule for all matches are final and cannot be altered.

Referee

The decision of the Official Referee, appointed by the Tournament Committee, will be final in all matters arising from matches of the Tournament.

Courts

All matches will be played on Rebound Ace Courts. Preliminary rounds will be played outdoors, with finals for the Parent & Child event to be played on the indoor center court. In case of wet weather, matches may be moved indoors.

Responsibility

THE CLEARWATER BAY GOLF & COUNTRY CLUB (THE CLUB) WILL NOT BE RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY DAMAGES OR PERSONAL INJURIES ARISING FROM THE TOURNAMENT.

Dress Code

Every player shall dress and present himself/herself for play in professional manner. Clean and customarily acceptable tennis attire shall be worn. Unacceptable attire such as sweatshirts, gym shorts, dress shirt, or other inappropriate attire shall not be worn during a match (including the warm-up). Any player who violates this section may be ordered by the referee to change his/her attire or equipment immediately. Failure of player to comply with such order may result in immediate default.
